To support these contracts AMEC has increased its workforce in Saskatoon to 314 from the 150 employed in 2006. AMEC also has established 135 contract positions from the 44 present in 2006. The company

plans to maintain this level of employment for at least three years.

To support new employees AMEC has implemented a program called "New Hire Interviews" where they meet with new employees on their 2nd, 6th and 12th month anniversaries to discuss the current concerns and opportunities. AMEC's safety program "Beyond Zero" is mandatory for all employees annually.
