Bio-Extraction Inc. ("BioExx") has a mission to develop, construct, own and operate oilseed processing facilities. Bio-Exx expects to be the first company worldwide to develop and commercialize a low temperature oil extraction and protein isolation system that allows for the separation and sale of very high value protein isolates from canola.

Since the beginning of 2008, Bio-Exx has invested over \$15 million in Saskatchewan for the development of a processing plant in Saskatoon which began operations in March of 2009. The company is planning to invest an additional \$20 million over the next 6-9 months, and is creating approximately 40 new jobs at its plant in Saskatoon.

In addition to the direct benefits of investment and employment at its first plant, through the deployment of this new industrial processing technology, Bio-Exx is creating new demand for canola growers and fostering downstream demand for its unique "Made in Saskatchewan" canola products on a global basis.
