Draganfly Innovations Inc. designs and sells unmanned aerial helicopters with professional videography apparatuses. These machines can perform many operations including search and rescue assistance, construction site inspection, aerial observation, and more.



In 2008, Draganfly Innovations launched the Draganflyer X6 helicopter. The Draganflyer X6 has an appearance nothing like a conventional helicopter, utilizing six main horizontal blades which allow it to hover efficiently and maneuver rapidly using differential thrust. The Draganfly X6 can also be put into GPS hold mode where it will maintain its position without any user input.

Draganfly Innovations expects the Draganfly X6 to continue to sell strongly, and the company is opening up its distributorship program worldwide on this product. Draganfly expects sales in 2009 to be strong with a minimum of 118 units sold and an average value per unit order of \$25,000. All research, development, manufacturing and marketing for the Draganfly X6 has occurred in Saskatchewan and in 2008, Popular Science awarded the Draganflyer X6 helicopter “Best of What’s New” for 2008 in the Aviation & Space category.
