Hub City Iron and Metal, Ltd. is a recycling depot for all ferrous and non-ferrous material. The depot is open to the general public and businesses. Businesses in and around Saskatoon can take advantage of the free bin services or their mobile operation can move machinery to locations throughout Saskatchewan and western Canada and cut and ship steel for recycling.

Hub City has removed appliances, batteries, and non-ferrous and other scrap materials from landfills around Saskatoon. The company has shipped for recycling thousands of tonnes of scrap metal each and every year for the past 20 years.

Hub City also has the capability to reduce wood waste. Wood waste is put through a shredder and broken down and separated from any steel waste. This is particularly useful when recycling pallets and waste of that sort.

With the addition of the mobile sector Hub City can move to any location needing large amounts of steel processed and are now one of the largest scrap metal recycling yards in Saskatchewan.
